1- Access

To access the Globethics Library, go to https://repository.globethics.net

2- Register/Create an account on Globethics Library

- Click on "Login" at the top right of the page on <u>https://repository.globethics.net;</u>
- Enter your Globethics user ID (i.e. email address) and password;
- If you have not yet registered on Globethics before, click on "Create an account" below the "Sign in" button and proceed with your registration;
- After registration, login with your Globethics user ID (i.e. email address) and password.
