Naan Mudhalvan platform aims to provide dynamic information for college students on courses and relevant information about industry specific skill offerings. This will enable the students of Tamil Nadu to get training in their chosen field of interest that will help them in achieving their career goals. The objective of this scheme is to identify potential training providers, to impart various skill trainings based on current industry gaps.

Through this flagship program the students will be able to get trained and ensure they get jobs according to their skill sets and also offer career and academic guidance to students in state educational institutions.

Naan Mudhalvan Scheme was inaugurated on 1-3-2022 all over Tamil Nadu by our Honorable Chief Minister through Video Conference. In our college, our Principal Dr.C.V.Mythili Presided over the function. Dr R.Shenbagavalli, Asst.Prof, Department of Computer Science was assigned as in charge (SPOC) for the Naan Mudhalvan Scheme and Dr Deepa, Associate Prof, Dept. of History, Dr.Anandha Dhanalakshmi, Asst.Prof, Department of English and Mrs Valli Meena, Asst. Prof, Dept. of Physics were assigned as the Supportive staff member.

In the first step, the college teachers were given Faculty Development Program training to guide the students by the industry people in the university for five days from 29-1-2023 to 2-2-2023

The following are the work Process going on by this scheme

- All 3,491 students were given assistance to onboard into the Naan Mudhalvan Portal
- For Ist Year Students, separate Login ID and Password were given to carry out the assignment sent by the Cambridge course. With the support of FDP Staff members, all students are in completion stage. Soon they will receive the certificates. Through this course, they enriched in Language
- For IInd year, a separate link has been provided to open the videos and assignments. Many students have received the certificates. Through this course, all students both Computer Science and Non-Computer Science are well familiar with Microsoft Fundamental
- For IIIrd Year, especially Computer Science, Maths and Physics students were given separate login IDs and Passwords to carry out the project work. Smart internz foundations explained the project work through an online video. Now, Students are well-advanced in carrying out the high-end project.
- For IIIrd year commerce and Economics, the seminar was arranged by NSE Academy to give an idea about Mutual Funds.
- For IIIrd Year Botany Students, the seminar was arranged by Apex to teach about Medical Coding
- For other department IIIrd students, the Employability Skill development program was conducted by Nanndi Foundations.

The following are the activities performed within our campus towards Naan Mudhalvan Scheme

1. From 6-3-23 to 8-3-23(3 days), the first meeting on Employability Skill Development Program was conducted for all IIIrd year except those who have attended FDP Program by Naandhi Foundation. There were some 11 trainers who had come and handled the class.



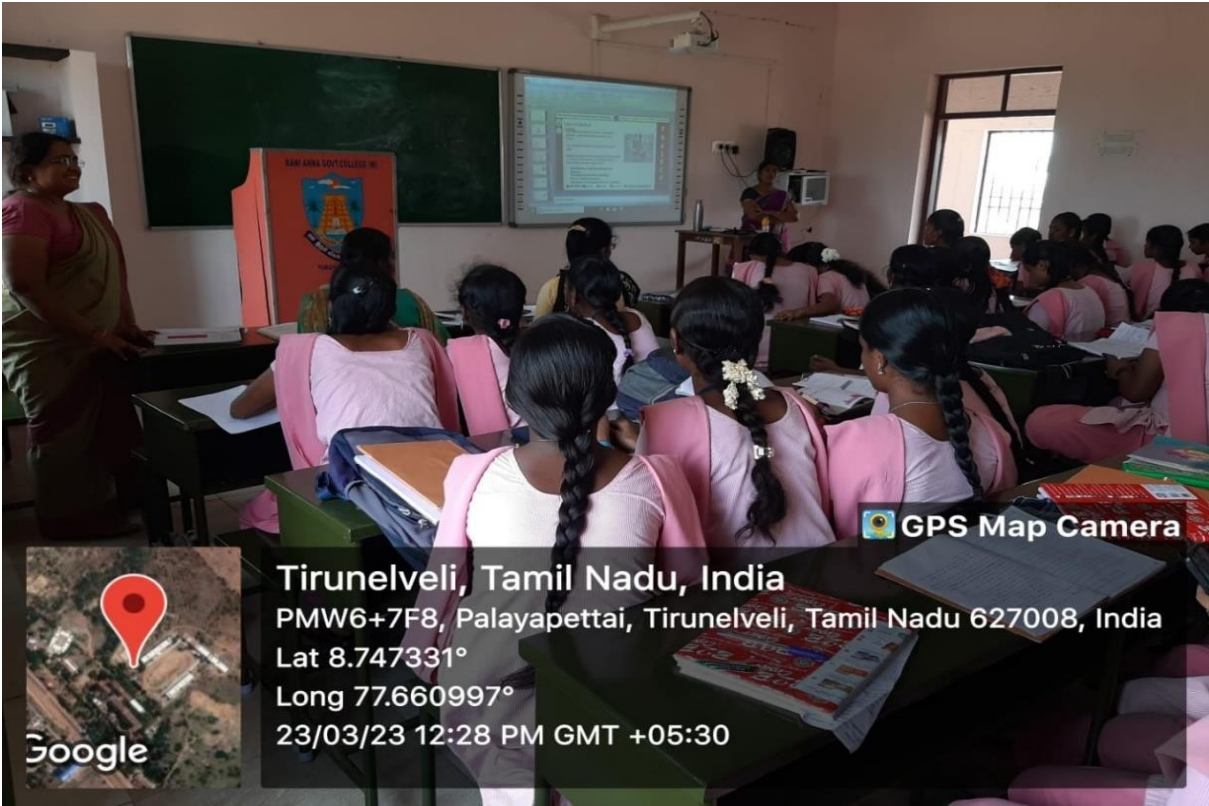
2. On 14-3-2023, 2 trainers from NSE Academy had come and gave a lecture on Mutual Fund

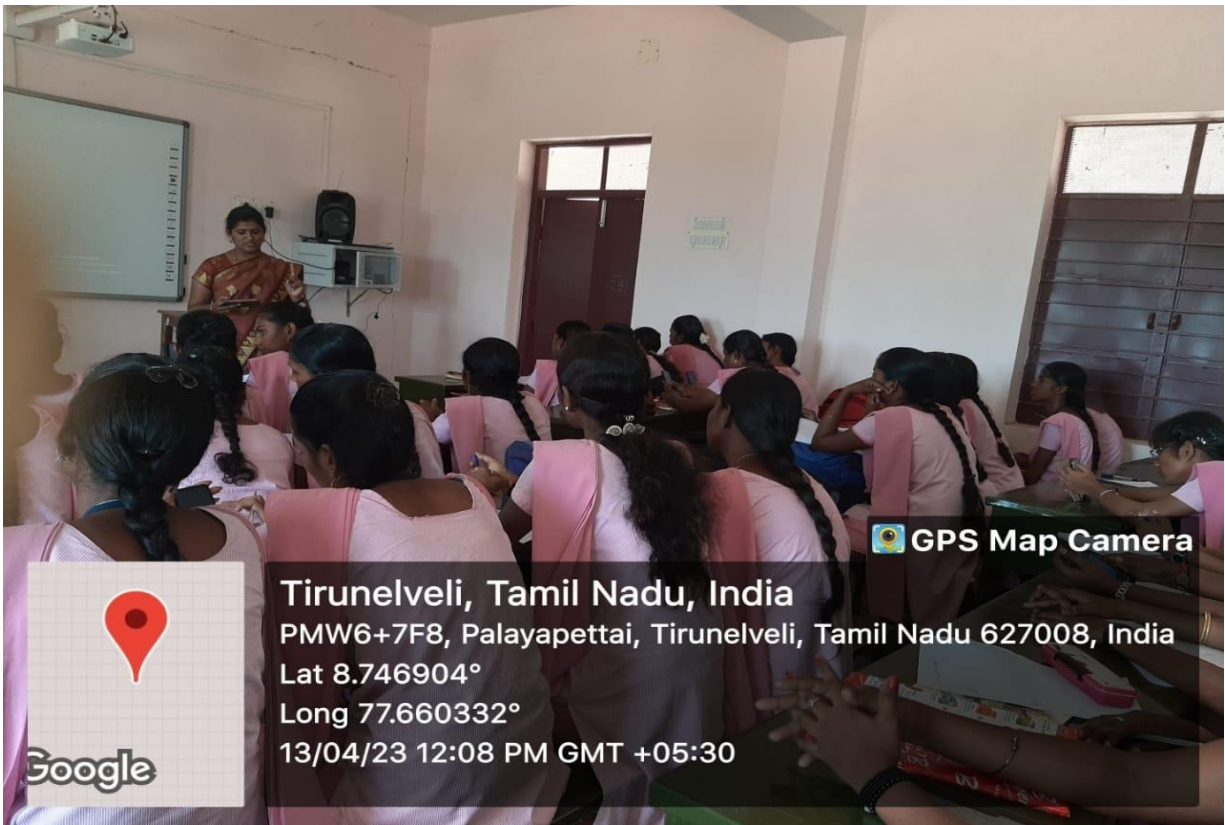


On 3-4-2023, Lecture on Mutual Fund from NSE Academy

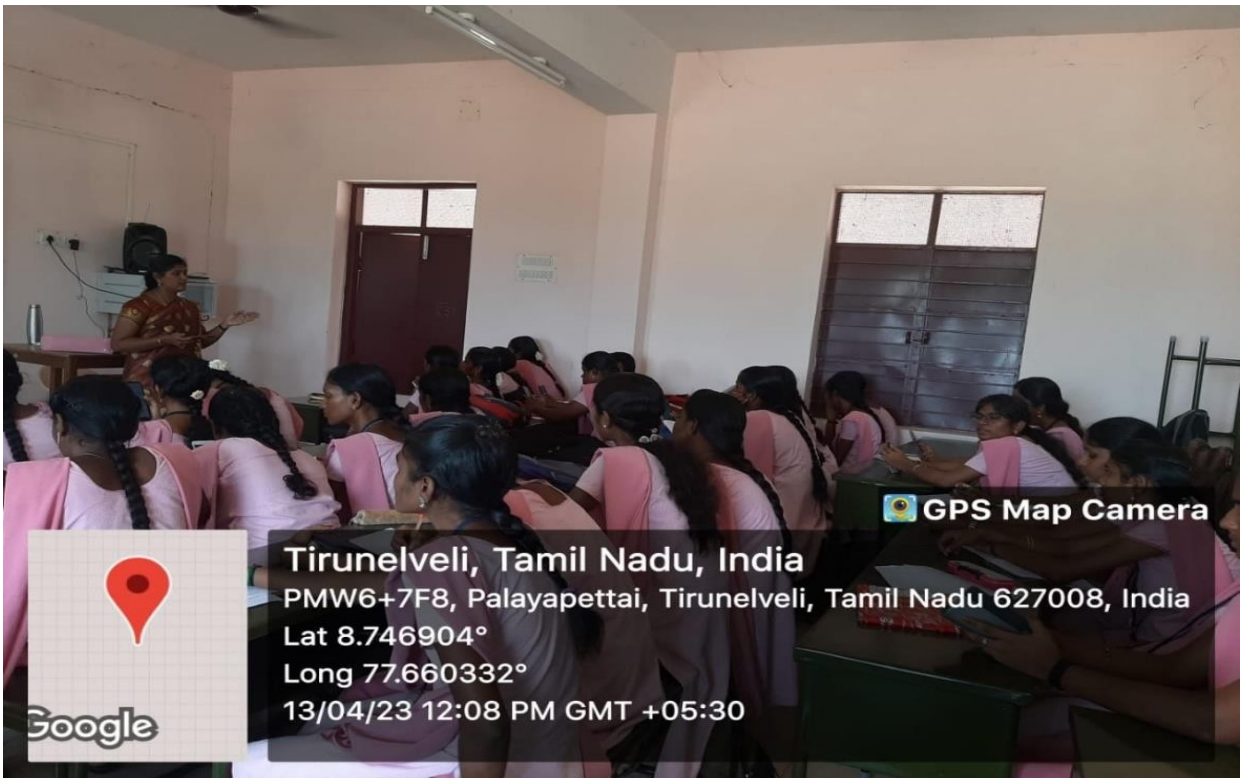




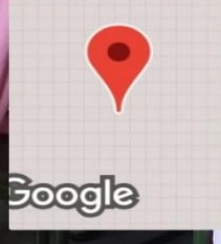
GPS Map Camera



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4. For Ist year students, Cambridge course training was given to them by 19 Trainers from Naandi Foundation from 27-3-2023 to 31-3-2023





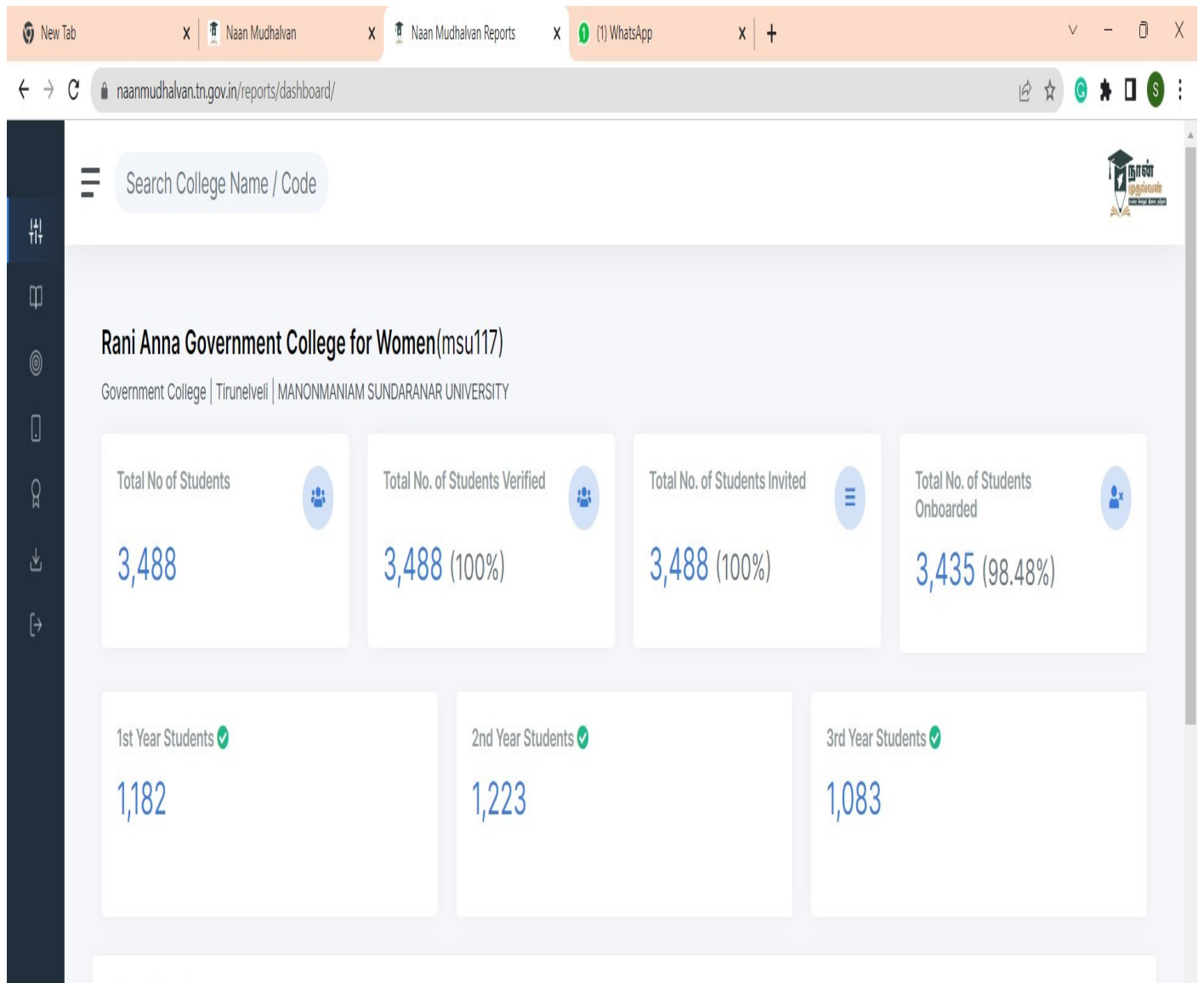
